THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES \$1,151,205 IN NEW GRANTS; OVER \$9 MILLION GIVEN SINCE FORMATION

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region announced today a total of \$1,151,205 in new grants to 73 non-profit community agencies at a reception at the Ballou Recreation Center. This is the eleventh year of operation for the Foundation, with total grants returned to the community now over \$9 million.

This year's grants contain \$750,000 in funding made available by a grant from the Danville Regional Foundation.
