Message From the President



After 20 years of dedicated service to The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region, Executive Director, Debra Dodson, announced to the board of directors her intentions to retire in the spring of 2019. During Debra's tenure with the Foundation, assets grew from \$10 million to \$36 million. Since its beginning in 1996, the Foundation has awarded \$24 million in grants and scholarships. Under Debra's leadership, strong internal control policies and procedures were implemented to meet National Standards for U.S. Community Foundations. The Community Foundation Board is extremely appreciative of all of Debra's contributions to the mission of the Foundation: to improve and enrich the lives of the people in our community.

To demonstrate our appreciation, a designated fund, the Debra Dodson Fund, was established in her honor. Grants will be made annually from the Fund for the benefit of Pittsylvania County Public Library and The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region.

A search committee was formed to seek a new Executive Director. After meeting with several potential candidates, a selection was made, and Katherine W. Milam is now the new Executive Director. She is a graduate of Emory University and has lived in Danville since 1990. She is active in several long-standing civic organizations, and is past president of Danville Riverview Rotary, Garden Club of Danville, and Danville Concert Association. She brings years of professional experience with strong organizational skills.

We are also very appreciative of Morgan Epstein, Program Officer, and Annette Roncaglione, Donor Services Manager, for all their support during the transition of leadership. Their continued professionalism and dedicated

service is most valuable.

However, everything that we are able to do is because of you, Our Donors. We are grateful for your trust and your generosity. Through your donations into a wide range of funds and scholarships, we are able to contribute support to the region's students and non-profit organizations. In fiscal year 2018-2019, the Foundation awarded \$218,440 in scholarships to 100 students and \$1,106,094 in grants.

We kindly ask you to continue to think about The Community Foundation when you are making philanthropic plans. What is The Community Foundation?

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region is an independent, public charity established in September 1996 by a steering committee of local civic leaders to gather permanent funds to support our area.

Each community foundation is fundamentally tied to a specific geographic area, where it works to serve the interests of donors, residents, and the community at large. Our primary service area is Danville/Pittsylvania County, Virginia and Caswell County, North Carolina. Donations are also being sought to build up resources for South Boston/Halifax County, with consideration given to other neighboring counties.

The Community Foundation offers a range of fund types and services to meet the varied philanthropic needs of its donors and the communities it serves.



What We Do

Giving

The mission of The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region is to improve and enrich the lives of people in our community by encouraging the generosity of donors; by receiving, managing and distributing important resources; and by meeting a variety of charitable purposes in our community.

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region donors are caring, forward-thinking individuals who entrust us to do good works in their names. The Foundation strives to enable people who love their community to easily give back. Whether their focus is education, the environment, arts and culture, or health and wellness, they have a professional partner and steward in The Community Foundation ready to put that passion into action. Our donors come from many walks of life, but share a common goal in using philanthropy to help people in the Dan River Region live better lives.

It is easy to establish a fund with The Community Foundation, whether you want to provide unrestricted support to meet the needs of the community or create an endowment for a favorite nonprofit. We welcome and appreciate charitable donations of all sizes. Gifts of \$10,000 (\$25,000 for scholarships) let you start a permanent charitable fund that has a name and purpose you select. There is no additional cost to set up a fund. Donors may

elect to start a fund by making a tax-deductible donation using cash, appreciated stock or an IRA charitable transfer. Future gifts are other options and can be made through a will, IRA or estate plan. Some donors choose to do both—give now as well as later. Our staff is happy to work with you or your professional advisor to help you create a charitable legacy that works best for you.

Grantmaking

During its 23-year history, The Community Foundation has provided grants and scholarships totaling nearly \$24 million. The Community Foundation's Distribution Committee determines a large portion of those dollars. The committee reviews applications over the fall cycle for grants and the spring cycle for scholarships. Because of the committee's conscientious work, the grant making process is thorough, fair, and effective in meeting needs in our community. We are extremely grateful to our volunteer Distribution Committee for their hard work and dedication.

Staff works diligently to carry out the wishes of donors and to provide expertise in local philanthropy. We stay tuned to developments in the nonprofit sector. If donors request information about an organization, we will research and share our knowledge so you can learn more about the causes you care about. We monitor the outcomes and impact of grants, with a goal of ensuring they are effective and efficient.

Fund Types

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region offers a variety of simple, flexible, and effective options for those who wish to provide financial support to our community through philanthropy. Donors can start their own named fund, or they can contribute in any amount to an existing fund of the Foundation.

Unrestricted Funds

Provide the greatest flexibility to tackle pressing community needs now and into the future. Contributions made with no restrictions provide income for grants made by the Distribution Committee in response to requests from area nonprofit organizations.

Field of Interest Funds

Donors specify areas of interest, such as youth, elderly, the arts, education, environment, or medical, to be supported by the fund.

Designated Funds

Donors name the organizations to benefit from the fund permanently.

Donor Advised Funds

Living donors periodically recommend grants to specific nonprofits and in what amounts.

Scholarship Funds

Donors establish an endowment to fund annual scholarships to help students pay for their education.

Agency Endowment Funds

Nonprofit organizations (agencies) create a permanent and predictable source of funding as a means of building charitable dollars for the future of their mission and work. The agency can add to the fund as well as individuals, organizations, and businesses.


Faye Carter Fund ('04)

The Faye Carter Charitable Trust of BB&T made its first distribution to The Community Foundation in 2004, which then established the Faye Carter Endowment Fund, a Field of Interest Fund, to benefit youth in the Danville area. To this day, The Community Foundation receives yearly distributions from the Faye Carter Charitable Trust at BB&T to grow the endowment and award more grants. The Faye Carter Fund of The Community Foundation has awarded 67 grants totaling over \$337,000 since 2006. Beneficiaries of this fund include Big Brothers Big Sisters, YMCA of Danville, Just Kids Child Development Center and the Danville Science Center.


W. Earl Allen & Elise M.G. Allen Fund ('98)

W. Earl Allen always tried to help the people of his community. Understanding the importance of a hometown bank, he helped to preserve the bank through the Depression and set an example of community service throughout his life. He began his career in 1919 as a bookkeeper with Chatham Savings Bank and was President of the Bank of Chatham when it was acquired by First & Merchants National Bank, a predecessor of Bank of America.

In 1988, a bequest from Mr. Allen's estate of 5,000 shares of NationalsBank stock was used to establish a Donor Advised endowed fund at The Community Foundation. The W. Earl Allen & Elise M.G. Allen Fund benefits the people of Chatham and Pittsylvania County. Thus far, the fund has provided \$136,600 in grants to various organizations, including Chatham Volunteer Fire Department, Northern Pittsylvania County Food Center, Pittsylvania County Literacy Program and Revitalization for a Greater Gretna.

Caswell Family Medical Center Endowment Fund ('18)

The Caswell Family Medical Center Endowment Fund was established as an Agency Endowment Fund in 2018 to provide support for the charitable work of the Caswell Family Medical Center. The Caswell Family Medical Center Board of Directors partnered with The Community Foundation to strengthen their legacy of providing patient-centered medical care for the community. Caswell Family Medical Center provides affordable, high quality, comprehensive healthcare services, and education to citizens of Caswell County and the surrounding area. The mission of the organization is to ensure access to medical care for everyone in the community, including the uninsured and the underinsured.

Fund for Halifax County ('10)

In 2010, Major General Carroll Thackston presented The Community Foundation with the establishing gift for the Fund for Halifax County. This Field of Interest Fund is a unique opportunity for citizens, organizations and businesses to help build an endowment to improve and enrich lives in Halifax County. Since inception, the Fund for Halifax County has awarded a total of 10 grants to organizations such as Main Street United Methodist Church, Triangle Volunteer Fire Department, South Boston-Halifax County Museum and The Good Samaritan.





Now is a great time to plan for your year-end giving and The Community Foundation is ready to help you! Use this handy checklist to be sure you are ready.

| Talk to your advisor. Before making any significant gift to charity, consult with your CPA, attorney or other advisor to understand the impact on your taxes and estate. |

| Consider your income. Take time to understand your tax liability for the year. Did your unearned income increase? Did you sell any appreciated assets? The answers to these questions may determine how much you want to give by December 31. |
| Review your stocks. If you'd like to make a year-end charitable gift, consider giving appreciated stock. Selling stock will incur capital gains on the appreciation, but if you gift stock, you will receive a charitable deduction for the current market value of the stock—just as you would with a cash gift. Such gifts are deductible up to 30% of your adjusted gross income and you can carry the deduction forward for up to an additional five years. |
| Give early and complete your gift by December 31. A gift by check is complete when mailed (postmarked) to the charitable recipient, even if not cashed until the following year. Gifts of stock and real estate are more complex; don't wait to make these gifts as it may be too late to make the necessary arrangements. |
| Give online. Save your stamps for sending holiday greetings. Giving online through www.cfdrr.org speeds up the process and ensures your gifts can get to work right away. A gift to The Community Foundation supports grantmaking to benefit the entire community. You can also search for particular funds to support local nonprofits and causes. |
| Give from your IRA. If you are 70 ½ or older, an IRA rollover gift is a smart way to donate. You may avoid taxes on transfers up to \$100,000 from your IRA to us; satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year; reduce your taxable income; and make a gift not subject to the 60% deduction limits on charitable gifts. Please note - the distribution must be sent directly to us from your IRA administrator - not first withdrawn by you and IRA distributions cannot be added to donor advised funds but can be donated to all other types of funds. |
| Give now—decide later. If you are planning for a charitable tax deduction this year but are undecided about which nonprofits to support, consider opening a donor-advised fund at the Community Foundation. You can claim a deduction for contributions to your fund now even though distributions from the fund might be made in future years. A donor-advised fund can be set up in one meeting. |
