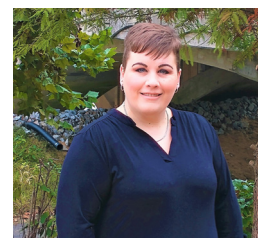

Reflections from the Board President

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region had another successful year in 2019-2020 in spite of some unexpected challenges. Total assets at the end of the year were \$39.1 million, which is a new high. The year began as a typical year for the Foundation as we continued to receive donations, establish new funds and employ resources to meet the philanthropic goals of our very generous donors. The Community Foundation continues to provide a powerful platform for the consolidation of assets from a broad donor base. This enables the Foundation to invest these assets efficiently to achieve returns that might not otherwise be possible. In accordance with our donors' wishes, the Foundation employs those assets to maximize the benefit to our community.

The Foundation could not exist without our community-minded donors. Because of your generosity, we created ten new funds during the year, received five new bequests, and added fifteen major gifts (defined as \$5,000 or more) to existing funds. In addition, there were 187 grants awarded totaling \$1,457,969 and 100 students received scholarships totaling \$240,784.

Then came 2020! With the onset of the pandemic, we were impacted like everyone else. It was necessary for us to re-assess our operations, and to determine how to best operate in this new environment. We also began to ask how the Foundation could meet some of the critical needs resulting from the devastating effects of the pandemic on the community. Collaborating with the Danville Regional Foundation, the decision was made late-March to establish a Coronavirus Relief Fund to provide emergency assistance for gaps in critical assistance. The Danville Regional Foundation very generously awarded The Community Foundation with a \$100,000 Challenge Grant to match other donations. We received contributions totaling \$253,755 and awarded grants totaling \$248,800.

To move resources quickly, the Foundation worked diligently to identify and prioritize the most compelling areas of need and distribute funds in a timely manner. Coronavirus Relief funding supported nonprofit and public entities that were actively



providing community safety nets for crucial services such as rent, utilities, food insecurity, childcare, and small business relief. Grants were awarded to assist organizations in Caswell County, City of Danville and Pittsylvania County.

The mission of the Community Foundation of the Dan River Region is to improve and enrich the lives of people in our community by encouraging the generosity of donors; by receiving, managing and distributing important resources; and by meeting a variety of charitable purposes in our community. By being flexible and adaptable to a changing environment, we accomplished our mission this year. We are keenly aware that it was only by the generosity of our very caring donors that our mission was fulfilled. We are most appreciative of the trust you have placed in us, and we are committed to holding this trust in the highest regard and to earning it on a daily basis.

Community foundations are focused locally and supported by local citizens with long-term goals of: building permanent funds established by many separate donors to carry out charitable interests, supporting broad-based charitable interests and benefitting residents of a defined geographic area, and serving in leadership roles on important community issues.

Our Mission

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region's mission is to improve and enrich the lives of people in our community by encouraging the generosity of donors; by receiving, managing, and distributing important resources; and by meeting a variety of charitable purposes in our community.

Who We Serve

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region's primary service area is the City of Danville and Pittsylvania County, Virginia and Caswell County, North Carolina. CFDRR also strives to continue to build resources and impact in Halifax County, Virginia.

A Bit of History about The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region (CFDRR)

Established in 1996 by a steering committee of local civic leaders to gather and manage permanent funds to enhance quality of life in the region, CFDRR is dedicated to responsible and effective community philanthropy. These funds are pooled and invested under the direction of a board of directors composed of community leaders. Income from the funds is distributed annually in the form of grants and scholarships. To date, CFDRR has gathered assets of more than \$39 million and awarded more than \$25.6 million in grants and scholarships. CFDRR is accredited by the National Standards for U.S. Community Foundations.

Facts about Community Foundations

- The first community foundation was created in 1914 in Cleveland, Ohio, and operates now as the Cleveland Foundation.
- Every continent but Antarctica has a community foundation, and it is estimated that there are at least 1,200 community foundations outside of the United States and Canada.
- As of 2020, there were over 900 community foundations in the United States. With the addition of affiliate community foundations that serve typically rural geographies, there are over 1,400 communities being served by a community foundation in the United States.
- Total giving by community foundations in 2015 was nearly \$7 billion. Community foundations in California gave the most, with total giving by community foundations in the state totaling nearly 1.5 billion dollars.
- Nearly every type of gift, from cash to real estate to bitcoin to stock, can be donated to a community foundation.

Fund Types

Donors can start their own named fund or contribute in any amount to an existing Foundation fund. The fund types include:

Unrestricted Funds

Provide the greatest flexibility to tackle pressing community needs now and into the future. Contributions made with no restrictions provide income for grants made by the Distribution Committee in response to requests from area nonprofit organizations.

Field of Interest Funds

Donors specify areas of interest, such as youth, elderly, the arts, education, environment, or medical, to be supported by the fund.

Designated Funds

Donors name the organizations to benefit from the fund permanently.

Donor Advised Funds

Living donors periodically recommend grants to specific nonprofits and in what amounts.

Scholarship Funds

Donors establish an endowment to fund annual scholarships to help students pay for their education.

Agency Endowment Funds

Nonprofit organizations (agencies) create a permanent and predictable source of funding as a means of building charitable dollars for the future of their mission and work. The agency can add to the fund as well as individuals, organizations, and businesses.

The Community Foundation's Coronavirus Relief Fund was established March 27, 2020 to provide emergency assistance for gaps in critical services caused by the economic fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic. Danville Regional Foundation matched \$100,000 of community contributions to the Fund.

SMART BEGINNINGS OF DANVILLE PITTSYLVANIA COUNTY: A COVID-19 STORY OF HOPE

Coronavirus Relief Fund Grant: \$50,000

Community Need: Smart Beginnings of Danville Pittsylvania County (SBDP) and its partners were concerned about the number of vulnerable parents "at home" with young children who were experiencing an increased amount of economic and emotional stress due to the pandemic.

Problem Solved: The Community Foundation Coronavirus Relief Fund grant enabled the distribution of 460 "Let's Play" resource boxes of age appropriate toys and books that supported nurturing and reassuring play for children ages birth-5 years. Each box supported the social and emotional needs of the family, including trauma informed guidance materials for handling child concerns and behavior during the crisis. SBDP also gave "Recognition Stipends" to 18 childcare providers who remained open during the pandemic to serve essential workers.

Challenges: SBDP's pivot to donate 80+ staff time hours for selecting appropriate age-level materials; identifying distribution partners; ordering and distributing materials; coordinating with vendor to ship the boxes from the east and west coasts; ensuring each parent received a "Letter to Parents" and a "First Aid for Feelings" booklet; making sure each family received the correct number of boxes.

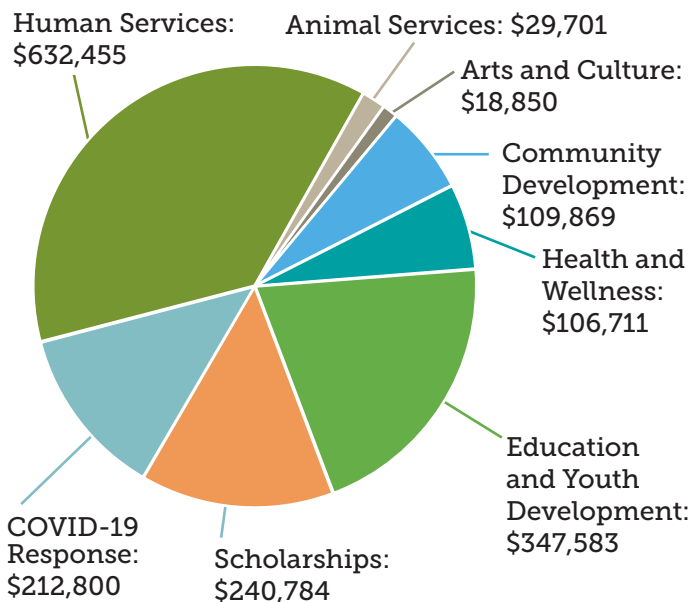

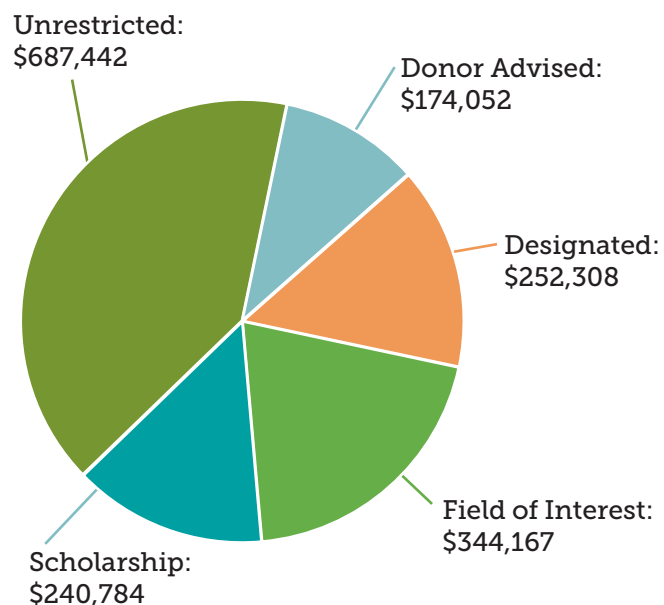
