One hundred and twenty-nine scholarships were awarded to area students totaling \$279,455 and 182 grants to partnering non-profit organizations totaling \$1,233,395.

The Foundation's investment approach for the assets entrusted to our management continues to provide a strong platform to every donor. The Foundation's assets totaled \$45,422,900 as of June 30, 2022.

Many of our non-profit partners are introducing new ideas and creating innovative programs that will help advance a shared vision of improving quality of life in the Dan River Region. Our Board and staff are excited by these opportunities, and we are looking forward to the bright

future of our communities in the coming year.

Vision

To recognize needs and provide resources to improve the quality of life in our community and to serve the wishes of our donors.

Mission

To improve and enrich the lives of people in our community by encouraging the generosity of donors; by receiving, managing and distributing important resources; and by meeting a variety of charitable purposes in our community.

What It Is

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region (CFDRR) was established in 1996 by a steering committee of local civic leaders to gather and manage permanent funds to enhance quality of life in the region. CFDRR is dedicated to responsible and effective community philanthropy. Community Foundations are fundamentally tied to a specific geographic area, where they work to serve the interests of donors, residents, and the community at large. For

CFDRR, the defined local geographic area includes Danville and Pittsylvania County, Virginia and Caswell County, North Carolina. Resources are also being sought for South Boston/Halifax County, with consideration being given to other neighboring counties. To meet the varied philanthropic needs of its donors and the communities it serves, The Community Foundation offers a range of fund types and services. The Community Foundation is a fully tax-exempt, public charity described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Internal Revenue Code.

How it Works

The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region accepts contributions, including cash, stocks, and other types of investments. These funds are pooled and invested under the direction of a Board of Directors composed of community leaders. Income from the funds is distributed annually in the form of grants and scholarships. To date, CFDRR has gathered assets of more than \$45.4 million and awarded more than \$27.1 million in grants and scholarships.

Legacy

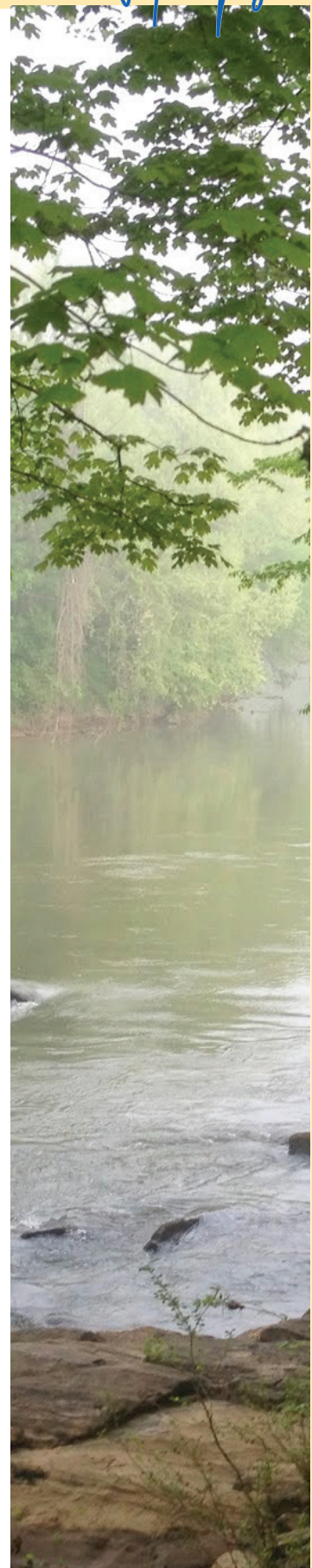

Establishing a Fund

- A straightforward and simple process.
- We offer several types of funds: Unrestricted, Donor Advised, Field of Interest, Scholarships, Designated Funds and Agency Funds.
- The required establishing gift for an endowed fund is \$10,000 and \$25,000 for a scholarship.
- If an individual or organization should require time to grow their fund balance to reach this minimum, we offer an Acorn Fund, which provides the donor a three-year period to attain the minimum required fund balance, at which point the fund becomes endowed.
- Donors are welcome to contact our office anytime for more information on establishing and administering a fund.

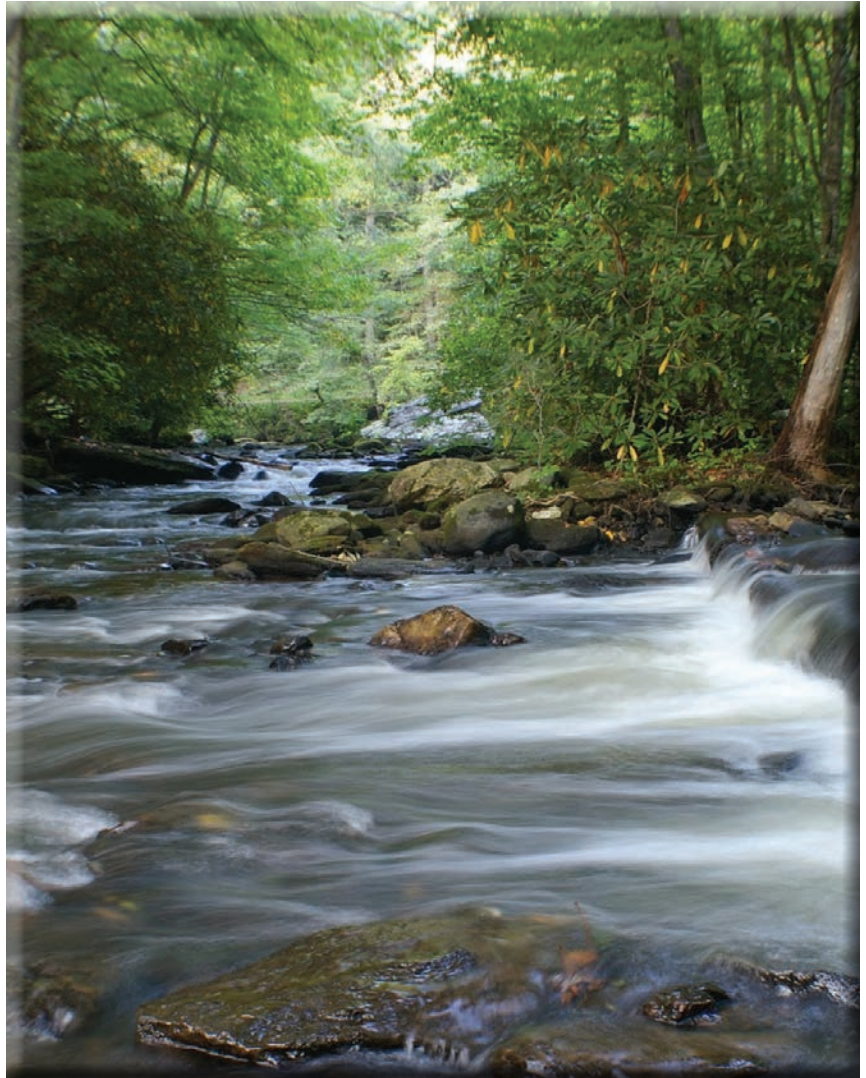

End of Year Giving Checklist

☐ **Talk to your advisor.**

Before making any significant gift to charity, consult with your tax advisor to understand the most efficient way to fulfill your philanthropic goals and for advice on your specific tax situation.

☐ **Consider your income.**

Take time to understand your tax liability for the year. Did your unearned income increase? Did you sell any appreciated assets? The answers to these questions may determine how much you want to give by December 31. If you itemize your deductions, non-cash gifts to public charities, including donor advised funds, are deductible up to 30% of your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI). Cash gifts are deductible up to 60% of your AGI.

☐ **Review your stocks.**

Consider giving long-term appreciated stock. Selling stock will incur capital gains on the appreciation, but if you gift stock, you will receive a charitable deduction for the current fair market value of the stock—just as you would with a cash gift. Plus you can carry the deduction forward for up to five additional years.

☐ **Give early and complete your gift by December 31.**

A gift by check is complete when postmarked to the charitable recipient, even if not cashed until the following year. Gifts of stock and real estate are more complex; don't wait to make these gifts as it may take additional time to make necessary arrangements.

☐ **Give online.**

Save your stamps for sending holiday greetings. Giving securely online through www.cfdr.org ensures your gift is received immediately. A gift to The Community Foundation supports grant making to benefit the entire community. You can also search for particular Community Foundation funds to support local nonprofits and special causes that are meaningful to you.

☐ **Give from your IRA.**

If you are 70 1/2 or older, a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD, or charitable IRA rollover) is a smart way to donate. Beginning at age 72, a QCD can count as your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). You may gift up to \$100,000 from your IRA and reduce your taxable income. Please note – the distribution must be sent directly to us from your IRA administrator. IRA distributions cannot be given to donor advised funds but can be gifted to any other type of fund.

☐ **Give now—decide later.**
