

2026 SCHOLARSHIPS

All applications must be submitted online prior to the deadline; therefore, students must begin the process in January to allow time for official transcripts and references to be received. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applicants must be full-time students to be considered for a scholarship.

- 1. Addison Singh Scholarship Open applications for students pursuing the field of sonography, or the field of radiology.
- 2. Adkerson-Dodson Special Education Scholarship Open applications for Danville/Pittsylvania graduates who are pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree or licensure in special education.
- **3. William E. Barr Scholarship** Open applications for Danville Pittsylvania County graduates attending Hampden-Sydney College.
- **4. Walter and Barbara Bass Scholarship** Open to Halifax County area high school graduating seniors who maintain a 3.0 GPA and have completed 120 hours of community service or are a member of JROTC.
- **5. Bennett-Bushnell-Jones-Kaufman Scholarship** Open applications to students enrolled in the Nursing Program at Averett University or Danville Community College and who maintain a 3.0 GPA. Preference will be given to RN students; however, if none are eligible, LPN students will be considered.
